"Committed, inspired physicians and dedicated communities are the essentials that have helped the Rural Ontario Medical Program (ROMP) grow since its conception in 1988. Partnering with communities and medical schools, ROMP has evolved and developed with the changing needs of rural and regional placements. Originally ROMP placed 40 rotations annually. Today that number has grown to over 1200 as community-based clinical rotations have thrived and are growing in all regions in the province of Ontario". ROMP continues its primary focus on Generalism in the province and developing new models of teaching for the Generalist practitioner. Defining communities healthcare needs are essential to defining healthcare training; community engagement and development remains central to our focus.

The Covid-19 Pandemic began in March 2020. Our program had a significant shift in distribution of learners. Undergraduate programs repatriated all learners. Postgraduate learners were reassigned. As a distributed program supporting education across many schools, ROMP was able to provide immediate reports and data. The pivot to off site offices was over night. The program remained dynamic and responsive to community need."

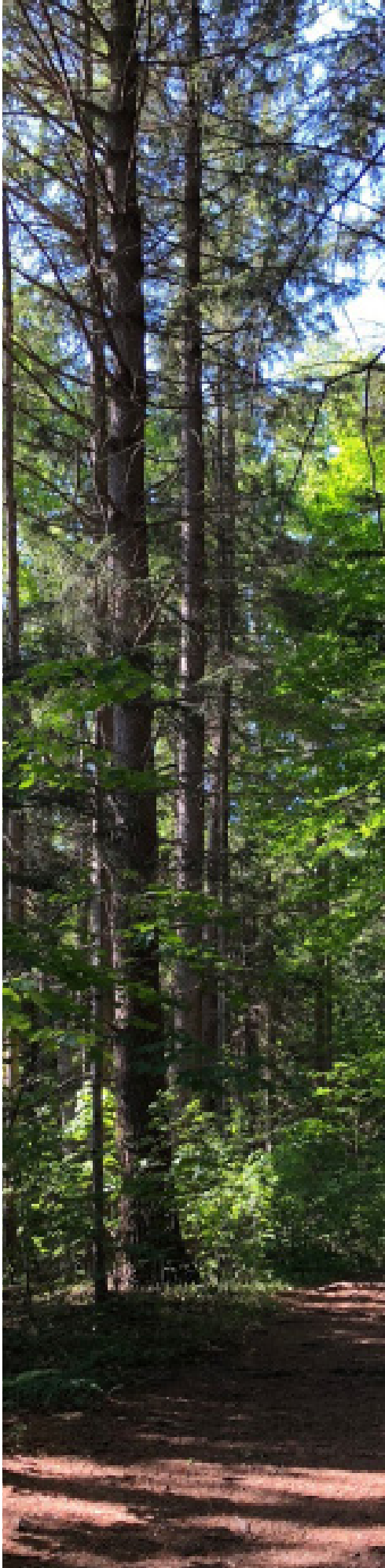

ROMP GOALS

To advance education through a placement program for health professional learners in rural communities and regional referral centers in Ontario, engaging practicing health clinicians, communities and health science centers;

To promote health and access to health by supporting recruitment and retention of healthcare professionals to rural and regional communities;

To improve rural population health by promoting the practice of rural and generalist medicine;

To promote rural population health and advance education by supporting the introduction of new models of healthcare delivery in rural communities through innovation, education and evaluation.

The Rural Ontario Medical Program is an organization which activates health professional education in the communities of Ontario.

ROMP supports POSTGRADUATE and UNDERGRADUATE learners from all six Ontario health science centres for clinical experiences in the community.

ROMP serves rural and regional Ontario with financial support for preceptors as well as travel and accommodation support for the learners experience away from the academic centre.

Through community rotation choreography, **ROMP** serves communities with the credentialing learners and preceptors, scheduling, recruitment, learner support and community integration.

Responding to the needs of Ontario communities, **ROMP** develops new projects and collaborations with universities for clinical education that supports the community and reaches social accountability mandates. From youth employment programs, cooperative programs, volunteer career growth to core clinical training, **ROMP** is facilitating learners across the continuum and engaging the appropriate community partners.

ROMP continues to move forward with research despite funding limitations. Our partnership with Georgian College Research and local community Quality Improvement Initiatives are evidence of that.

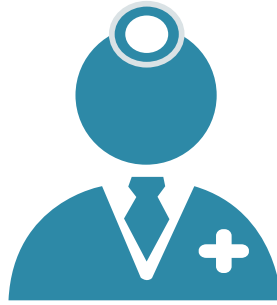
Many of the rural family medicine residency programs we support have learners who build relationships with the community and over 70% will stay in the local area for practice. This research was presented at the National Society for Rural Physicians of Canada and the Association of Family Health Teams of Ontario. **ROMP** has continued to be a growing demand amongst learners and preceptors within Ontario. Now serving over 65 rural and regional communities of Ontario, **ROMP** has well over 1200 preceptors registered to date. Our rotation provision grows not only with medical learners but also in the areas of physician assistant, midwifery, dietary and others. **ROMP** is a hub of community partnerships which serves to provide future practitioners with skills and abilities to practice in the rural and regional community in Ontario and Canada.

THE QUEENS SCHOOL OF MEDICINE

In 2022 – 2023, the Queen's clerkship program supported over 144 months of training in a variety of communities across the region predominantly in Family Medicine.

As a part of this year's Queen's Integrated Clerkship Program, Clarington Township hosted 8 learners for 26 training months, Collingwood hosted 5 learners for 18 training months, and Cobourg hosted 4 learners for 15 training months; a total of 59 teaching months.

In addition to undergraduate core placements, ROMP placed over 48 months of undergraduate elective training across 3 specialties in Barrie, Clarington Township, Collingwood, Listowel, Midland-Penetanguishene, New Tecumseth, Northumberland, Orillia, Owen Sound, Peterborough, Uxbridge, Walkerton, and Wingham. Elective funding was provided by Queen's University on a one-time basis.

ROMP provided outreach presentations to Queen's undergraduate learners both for core and elective experiences. ROMP continues to place learners in each core Family Medicine block for Queen's UG Family Medicine

In Family Medicine, 35 PGY1s and PGY2s completed 61 months of training, both core and elective with Family Medicine and Royal College preceptors.

ROMP continues to support Queen's FMTU learners who spend 2 years in Peterborough. In 2022/23 ROMP provided over 68 months of rotation support.

The PGY3 Program consisted of a total of 26.75 training months shared amongst the Family Medicine Emergency Medicine, Enhanced Skills, and Anesthesia programs.

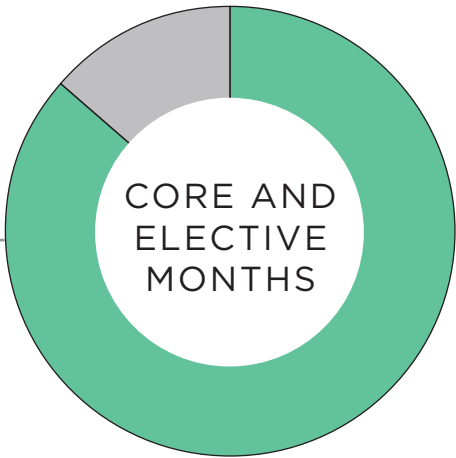

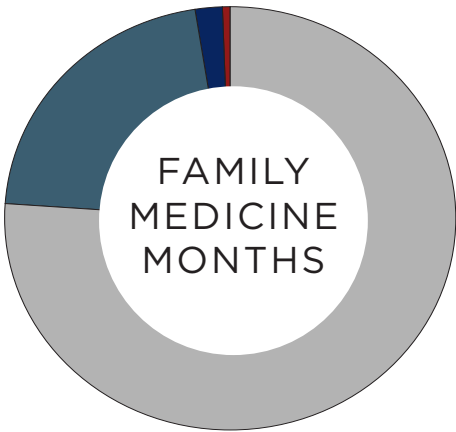

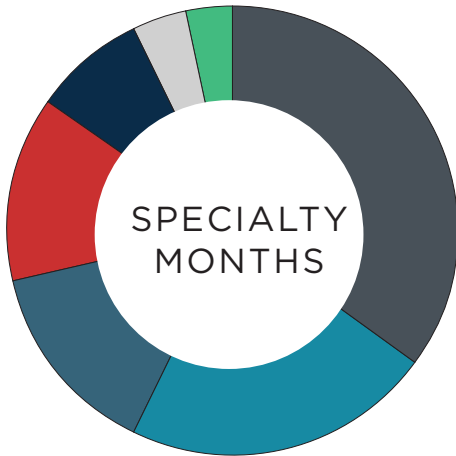

McMASTER - MICHAEL G DEGROOTE

This year, 35 core clerkship placements were organized and funded in Pediatrics, Psychiatry, and Obstetrics/Gynecology. Elective rotations continue to decrease due to lack of funding. A trend saw 3 learners from the Physician Assistant program receive 6.5 months of training in the region. The program also saw one Physical Therapy and five Midwifery students' complete rotations for a total of 11 months.

In 2022/23 ROMP supported and funded 255 months of Postgraduate training. There were 177 training months provided for Family Medicine residents in a variety of rural and regional settings within the 2 years of training (both urban and rural streams) as well as the third-year program.

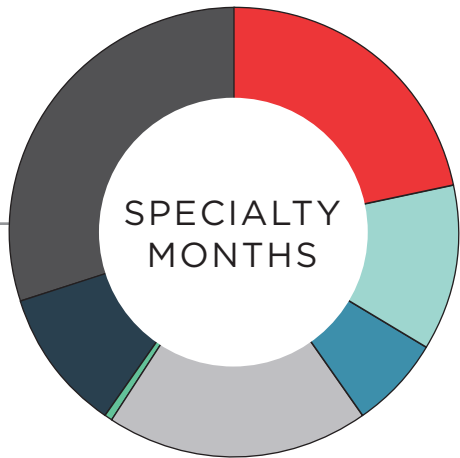
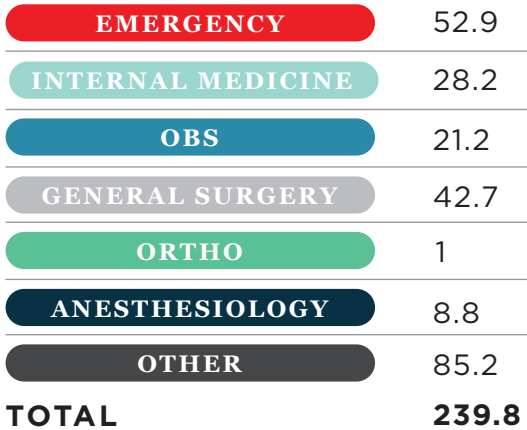
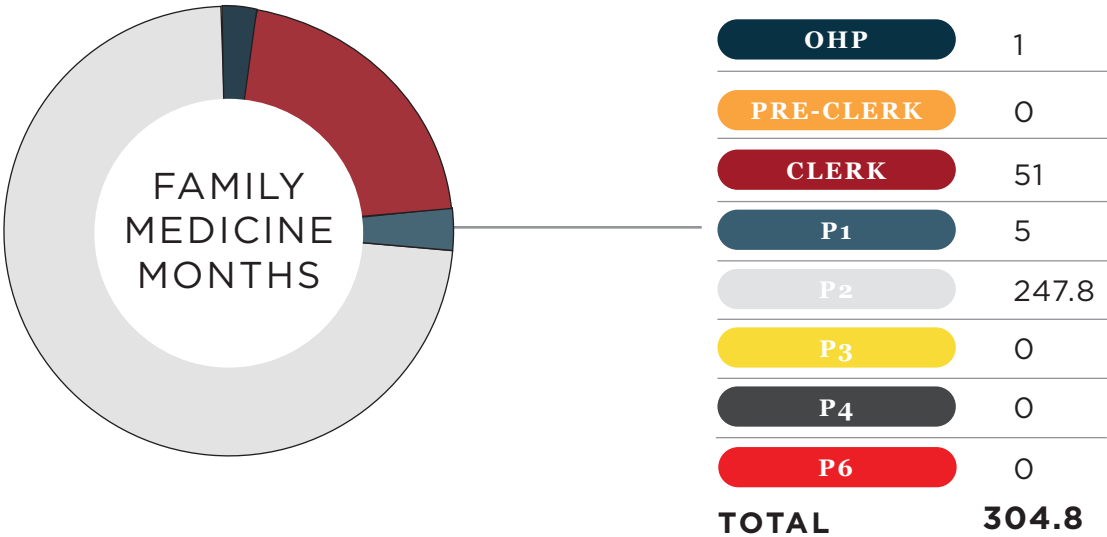
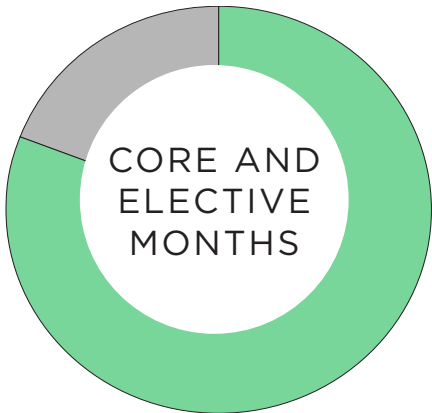
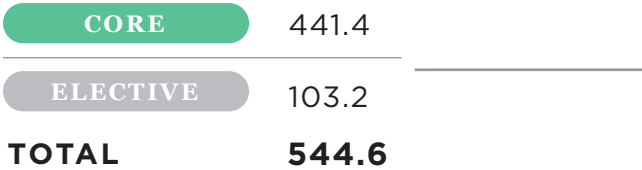
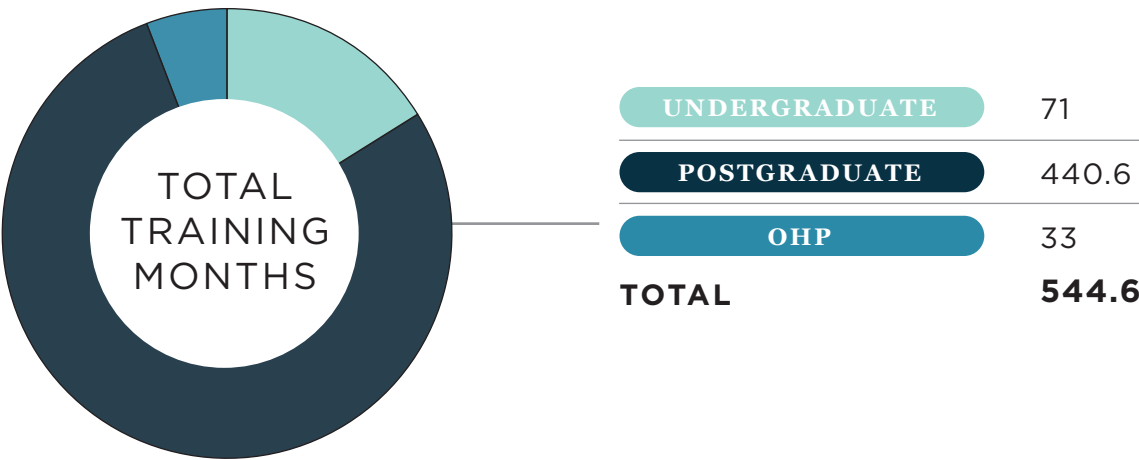
Over 13 months of Royal College resident clinical education was supported by ROMP.

ROMP continues to support and provide assistance with the Department of Family Medicine Rural Stream at McMaster. The collaboration with the DFM and ROMP is to support the Collingwood, Mount Forest and Owen Sound residency programs. With funding and administration from ROMP, 10 residents participate in the program each year. In 2022/23, ROMP supported and funded approximately 87 months of training.

In collaboration with McMaster for PGY3 Family Practice Anesthesia, ROMP supported and funded 11 months for the FPA residency program. ROMP also supports and funds the FPA Boot Camp held in Sudbury for the McMaster residents to attend. ROMP also provided support to McMaster's PGY3 Enhanced Skills program and funded 6 months of training for 4 learners.

THE UNIVERSITY OF TORONTO FACULTY OF MEDICINE

In 2022/23, ROMP provided 25 University of Toronto undergraduates rotation support for 37 months of generalist experiences for their core Family Medicine rotations. A trend saw 16 learners from the Physician Assistant program receive 27 months of training in the region, which is an increase from 2021/22 of approximately 16 months. The program also saw 2 Nurse Practitioner students' complete rotations for a total of 6 training months. A total of 71 months of core and elective training was provided and funded for clinical clerks. In addition to core

Family Medicine, learners completed electives and their Transition to Residency in a variety of specialties. We continue to see a decline in elective placements due to lack of funding.

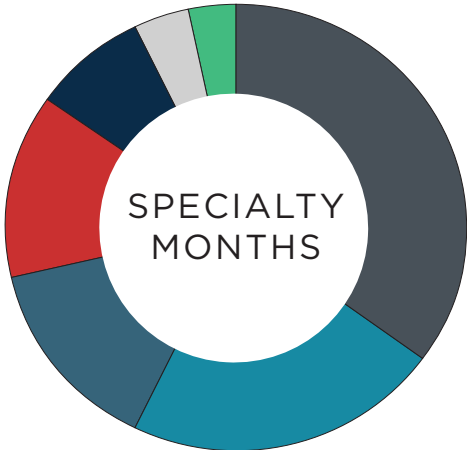
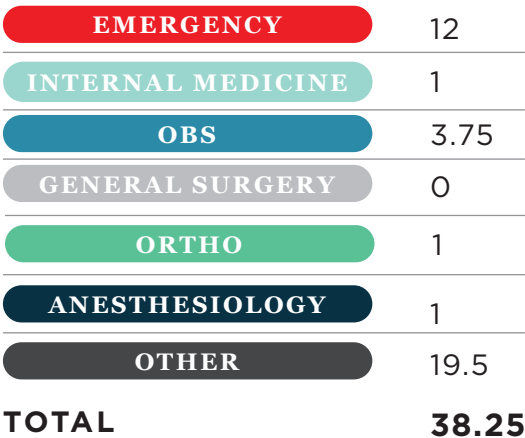
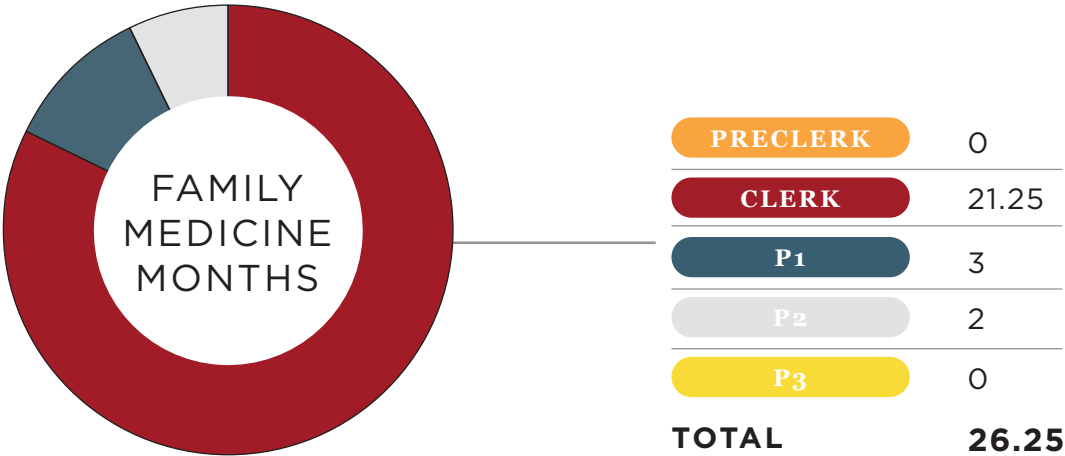
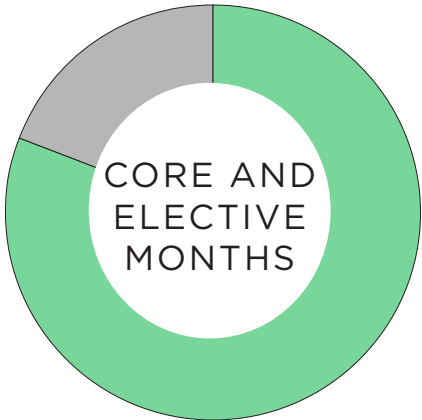
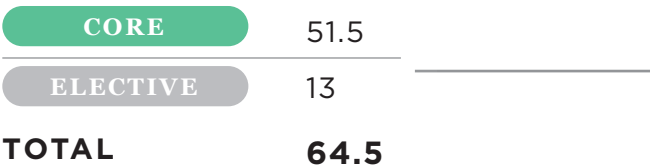
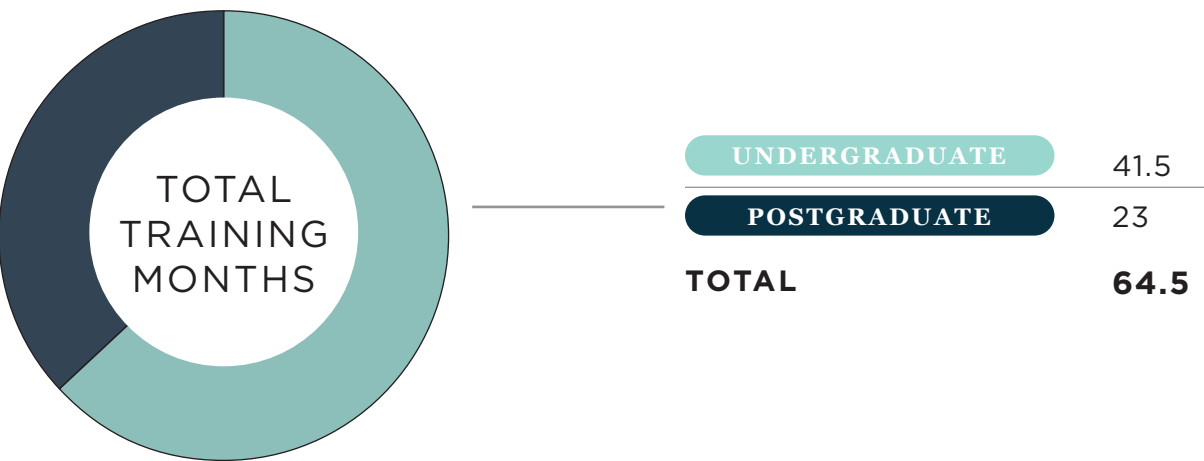
With University of Toronto postgraduate training, 208 months were funded and supported in 2022/23. Approximately 78.05 months of training was facilitated for University of Toronto Royal College program residents inclusive of: Anesthesia, Neurology, Emergency Medicine, General Surgery, General Internal Medicine, Obstetrics & Gynecology, Ophthalmology, Orthopedic Surgery, Pediatrics, Public Health and Preventative Medicine, Psychiatry, and Radiation Oncology .

The Department of Family and Community Medicine at the University of Toronto recognized 151 months of training funded and supported by ROMP in 2022/23. In addition, another 203.5 PG learner months were organized and facilitated, without funding by ROMP. Learners participated from the Barrie FMTU, Rural Resident Stream, PGY3-Program, as well as the two-month rural program - Teaching Practices.

ROMP continues to support the SEME program for community-based rotations and hosted 2 learners in 2022/23. The Rural stream of 15 learners was funded for 50 months of training. The Barrie Family Medicine program with over 33 different learners were supported for 84.95 funded months, and the Markham learners were supported for 7 months of rural training. In 2022/23 ROMP coordinated 113 learners with the Teaching Practice program for 191 months of rural education. ROMP also provided support to 4 residents from the University of Toronto's PGY3 programs for a total of 4 training months.

UNIVERSITY OF OTTAWA

2022/23 A YEAR IN REVIEW





FACULTY OF MEDICINE OTTAWA UNIVERSITY

In 2022/23, 30 learners from the University of Ottawa were supported for ROMP Week. These learners were distributed in Barrie, Collingwood, Markdale, Meaford, Midland-Penetanguishene, Orangeville-Shelburne, Owen Sound, and Port Perry.

This year, 34 months of clinical education was supported and funded by ROMP for third year clinical clerks from the University of Ottawa. Rotations were inclusive of core Family Medicine (21.25 months), Obstetrics & Gynecology (3.75 months), and Psychiatry (9 months). Elective rotations continue to decrease due to lack of funding.

For postgraduate learners from the University of Ottawa, a total of 23 months were supported by ROMP with 20 of those provided funding. These were a mix of Family Medicine, PGY3 Emergency Medicine, General Surgery, Internal Medicine, Urology, and Anesthesia.

Approximately 12 months of training was facilitated for 12 University of Ottawa Royal College program residents inclusive of Emergency Medicine, Anesthesia, General Internal Medicine, Urology, and General Surgery.

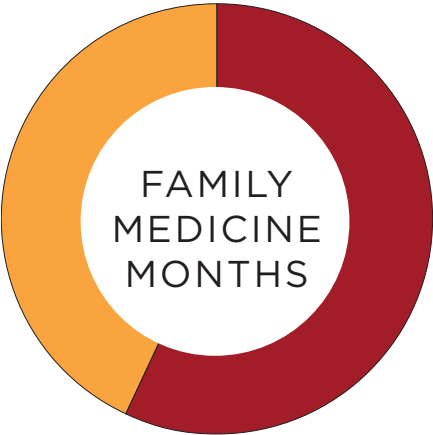
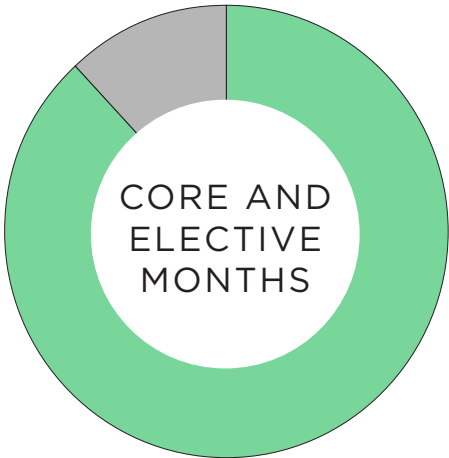

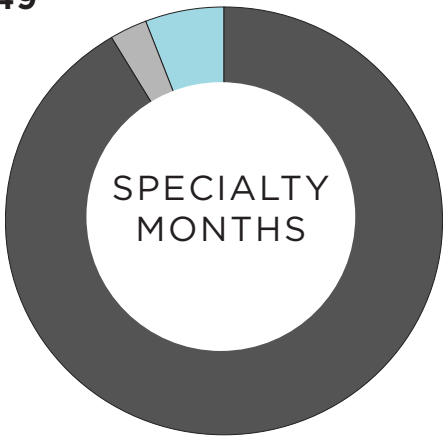

In 2022/23, ROMP provided 53 months of training for undergraduates from NOSM. These rotations were a combination of core CBM (21 months), Midland CCC (28 months) and elective rotations (4 months). Elective rotations continue to decrease due to lack of funding.

ROMP also funded and organized 22 months of training for NOSM postgraduate learners. In addition, another 9 resident months were organized and facilitated without funding. Postgraduate rotations consisted of Family Medicine (2 months), PGY3 Emergency Medicine (1 month), and Royal College (28 months) rotations. Royal College programs consisted of Public Health and Preventative Medicine, General Surgery, General Internal Medicine, Rheumatology, and Psychiatry.

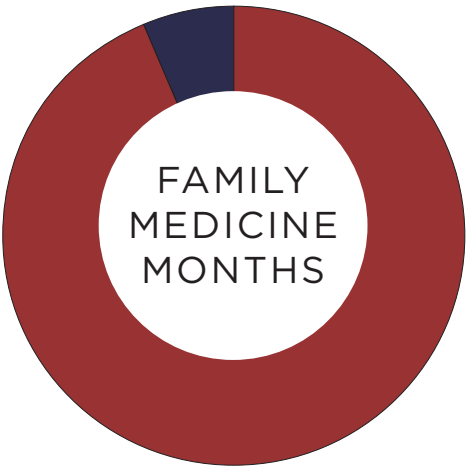
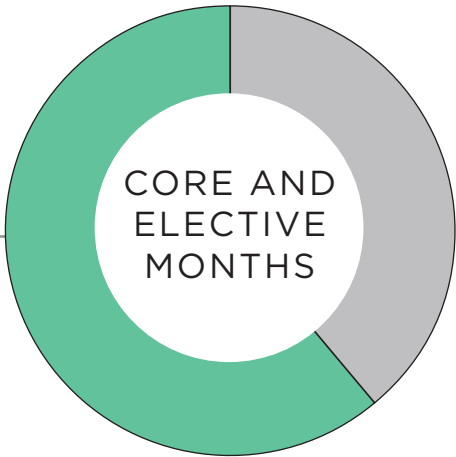

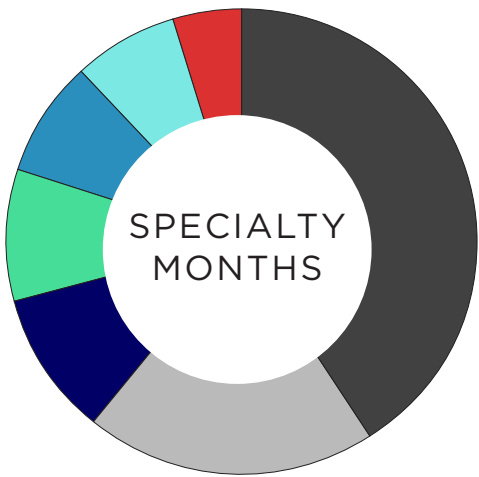

SCHULICH SCHOOL OF MEDICINE & DENTISTRY

In 2022/23, undergraduate learners from Western University were organized for 25.75 months of unfunded training clinical education experiences. Elective rotations continue to decrease due to lack of funding. The rotations were predominantly in Family Medicine (15.25 months) with other placements in Anesthesia, Emergency Medicine, Pathology, Obstetrics & Gynecology, and Pediatrics. ROMP facilitated and funded 34 months of postgraduate learner clinical education. ROMP also supported 11.5 months of unfunded training.

12 months of training was funded for 9 Royal College residents in Anesthesia, Emergency Medicine, General Surgery, Critical Care Medicine, and Pediatric rotation types. In addition, 10.5 months of training was unfunded for 8 Royal College residents.

The Rural Stream program consisted of 21 training months for 7 learners in Anesthesia (4 months), Emergency Medicine (1 month), General Surgery (5 months), Hospitalist (1 month), Internal Medicine (4 months), Obstetrics & Gynecology (3 months), and Palliative Medicine (3 months) rotation types.

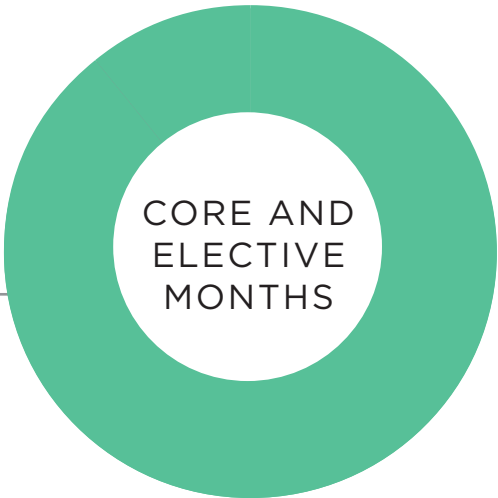

IN 2022/23, ROMP FACILITATED 9.5 TOTAL MONTHS OF ROTATIONS FOR LEARNERS COMPLETING THE DEPARTMENT OF NATIONAL DEFENCE'S MEDICAL OFFICER TRAINING PLAN (MOTP) OR PHYSICIAN ASSISTANT TRAINING PLAN (PATP). BETWEEN THESE TWO PROGRAMS, .5 TRAINING MONTHS WERE AT THE UNDERGRADUATE LEVEL AS PART OF THE PATP, WITH AN ADDITIONAL 9 MONTHS COMPLETED AT THE POSTGRADUATE LEVEL AS PART OF THE MOTP.

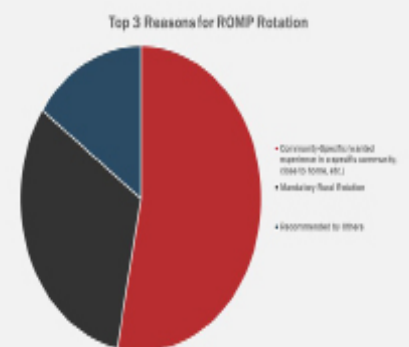
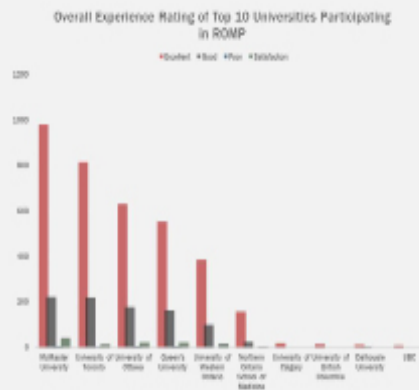

Purpose of the study

We were directed to identify the influences ROMP has made on participants both during and after enrolment in the program. Our analysis gives ROMP insight into learner experiences and the factors contributing to the success of the program.

Conclusions

Based on surveys spanning nearly 30 years, ROMP achieves its mandate in supporting the encouragement of medical students to continue their careers in rural and small communities. Only 6% of respondents answered that they would establish their careers elsewhere. Our analysis can only reinforce the benefits of the program. Recommendations might only include more prominent promotion of ROMP to raise awareness of its contribution to the future and development of medical practice across Southern Ontario.

Purpose of the study

The main purpose of this study was to evaluate the impact of ROMP experience on subsequent medical practice of physicians and to determine the main factors affecting the choice of practice location.

Methodology

Retention rate :

47% of respondents currently practice in rural areas.
Out of the 47% of physicians practicing in rural areas, 53% had placement in the rural area **only with the ROMP**.

Professional profile:

81% of physicians identified themselves as “generalists”. Out of that 81%, 64% had their placement only with the ROMP.

Factors influencing the choice of practice in rural area:

the ability to use a wide range of skills, work-life balance, ability to work in various health settings.

Experience with the ROMP:

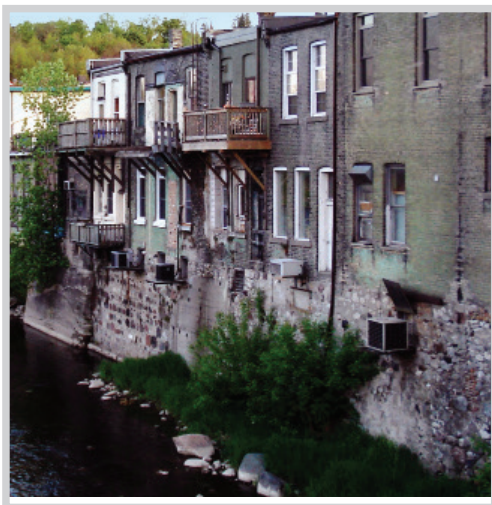
All respondents expressed a high level of satisfaction with the ROMP experience.
83% of respondents were very likely to recommend the ROMP.

Conclusions

In conclusion, it is reasonable to infer that the ROMP influences physician decisions to practice in rural areas. The meaningful experience physicians obtain during their placement with the ROMP serves as a stimulus to continue practicing in rural locations.
